- VEHICLES:** All units must be 50% decorated except for those carrying royalty, VIP's or are antique.
- ANIMAL ENTRIES:** Necessary clean up equipment **MUST** accompany each entry.

- Exhaust pipes must be wrapped with non flammable material and not be near paper or decorations.
- Proper driver vision and ventilation **is required**.
- All vehicles to be in good mechanical condition.
- All participants on floats **MUST** wear safety belts or have hand-holds or railings close by whilst float is moving.

All participants must be made aware that the City of Courtenay, sponsors, any employees, associates, members and volunteers are not responsible for any damage or accidents that may occur prior to, during or after the event. The participant is responsible for ensuring they follow the guidelines set forth. Noncompliance of Guidelines and Safety Regulations may result in dismissal from participation.

WAIVER/RELEASE

On Consideration of the City of Courtenay and the sponsors permitting participation in the parade, the participant hereto agrees as follows:

- TO WAIVE ANY CLAIMS** that the participant may have against the City of Courtenay, the Sponsors and their Directors, Officers, Employees, representatives and agents and any volunteers in any way associated with parade (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees")
